

# Methodology (2025) and Background

- ◆ **Study:** the sociological monitoring project "Ukrainian Society" has been conducted since 1994.
  - ◆ **Design:** the research instrument was developed by the Institute of Sociology of the NAS of Ukraine.
  - ◆ **Population:** the findings are representative of the adult population of Ukraine, excluding the temporarily occupied territories of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea and parts of the South and East.
  - ◆ **Method:** data were collected via computer-assisted telephone interviewing (CATI) using a randomly generated sample of mobile phone numbers.
  - ◆ The **fieldwork** for the 2025 wave was carried out from September 9 to October 8.
  - ◆ **Margin of Error:** For the sample size of 1,835 respondents and a 95% confidence level (design effect of 1.1), the margin of sampling error does not exceed  $\pm 2.4\%$ .
  - ◆ **Sample Profile**
    - Mean age – 49.2 years
    - Gender – Male: 44.7% Female: 55.3%
    - Settlement Type – Regional center: 39.3% Other town/city: 31.5% Village: 29.2%
    - Education – General secondary or lower: 14.8% Vocational secondary: 35.6% Higher: 49.5%
    - Displacement Status – Have not relocated: 73.2% Relocated and returned: 15.7% Displaced: 11.2%

# How much money does your household currently require per person per month to achieve a normal standard of living, as you understand it? (Values are converted into dollars at the appropriate exchange rate)




# To what extent does your household's actual monthly income per person correspond to the amount you previously indicated? %




■ Significantly lower


# How would you assess the current economic situation in Ukraine? %




# Which of the following best describes your political or ideological views? %




## How would you assess the effectiveness of the central government at this stage? %




# What do you think about the future of Ukraine? %




# In general, how would you assess living conditions in Ukraine for most of the population? %




# How would you assess Ukraine's achievements and failures from 1991 to the present? %



# To what extent do you feel satisfied with the current situation in Ukraine? %




# General attitudes towards the functioning of the state, %




■ Strongly negative

## In your opinion, what unites people in Ukrainian society today? (2024) %




# What social groups do you think play a significant role in the life of Ukrainian society? (2024) %




# Perception of cynicism in society, %
